The **Annual Parish** or Town Meeting is **not** a council meeting.

It is a meeting of the parish or town electors taking place between 1 March and 1 June.

Electors can contribute to the agenda and in practice these meetings often celebrate local activities and debate current issues in the community.

The chairman of the council, any two Councilors or any six electors can call the Annual Parish or Town Meeting.

The Chairman, if present, will chair the meeting.

****It is best practice to hold the Annual Meeting of the Council and the **Annual Parish Meeting** on different occasions to avoid confusion.**
